

# Consent to Receive Text Messages

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Your health care provider wants you to use Honest Health's platform to help you manage your care. The platform gives you tools like a virtual care team assistant, remote monitoring, appointment reminders, and information about your health. Your provider may send you text messages through this platform.

Text messages are not always fully private. There is a small chance someone else could see the messages sent between you and your care team. People who use your phone or can see your screen may also see your messages. These messages might show that you have certain health conditions.

If you reply “Y” or “Yes” to the enrollment text, you agree to receive text messages from your health care provider. You also understand that someone else could see these messages. If you choose not to receive texts, your provider will still care for you, but you will not get the reminders and tools sent by text.

By replying “Y” or “Yes,” you also agree that your provider may send repeated automated text messages to the mobile number you gave them. You do not have to agree to receive texts to get care *from your provider*. Message and data rates may apply. Text “STOP” to cancel. Text “HELP” for help.

By responding “Y” or “Yes,” you confirm that you are at least 18 years old and able to agree to this for yourself.

If you are receiving or sending messages for someone else, such as a child, parent, or partner who is the patient, you confirm that you have the legal right or permission to communicate with their health care provider and use Honest’s platform for them.
